

How to send Lent Appeal donations

We would like you to send your Lent Appeal donations directly to The Leprosy Mission, and not to the Diocese. The Leprosy Mission will confirm your gifts have arrived safely upon receipt, and will provide a report to the Diocese of all donations at the end of the Lent Appeal.

Your church may already have a Leprosy Mission Church Representative who knows how to pay in donations. If not, there are four ways to send your donations to The Leprosy Mission, whether from your church or from you as an individual.

Cheque

You can send cheques made payable to The Leprosy Mission to:

Whether the cheque is from you as an individual or from your church, please include the reference 25RCLT with your name, your church's name and postcode
